# Larmia Listach Conerly

**L**armia Listach Conerly, age 83, entered eternal rest peacefully on the afternoon of Tuesday June 21, 2022, at Hospice House of Slidell, surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Natchitoches, Louisiana, on July 7th, 1938, to Nora Listach and Annie Lee Gillie Listach.

Larmia is survived by her grief-stricken children, Shaun Ray David Conerly (Kimberly Conerly, wife), of Madison, Mississippi; and Linnette Conerly Goodly, of Covington, Louisiana. 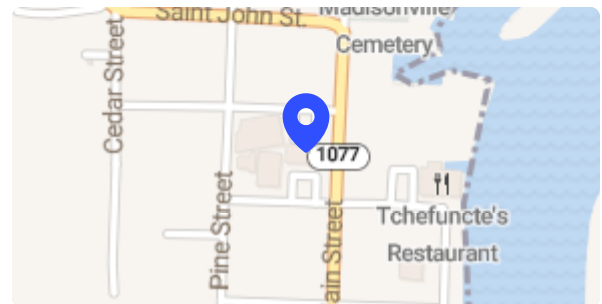

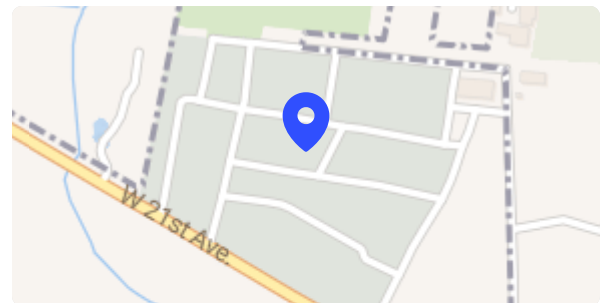
