Marvin Ray Halbrook, at the age of 90, peacefully entered eternal rest on Monday evening of August 15, 2022 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Iota, Louisiana on June 26, 1932 to Otto Haack and Edna Roy Haack Halbrook.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 60 years, Beverly Russell Halbrook and his children, Matthew Halbrook (Rebecca) and Kelly Halbrook Bement (B.J.). Marvin was the proud grandfather of Rachel Elizabeth Halbrook and Tristan Michael Halbrook. He is also survived by a host of wonderful lifelong friends.

Marvin is preceded in death by his son, Brandon Michael Halbrook; his parents, Otto and Edna Haack Halbrook; and stepfather, John Henry Halbrook.

A native of Iota, and a longtime resident of Mandeville for over 37 years, Marvin graduated from Sulphur High School at the age of 15. After high school, he proudly joined the United States Navy. 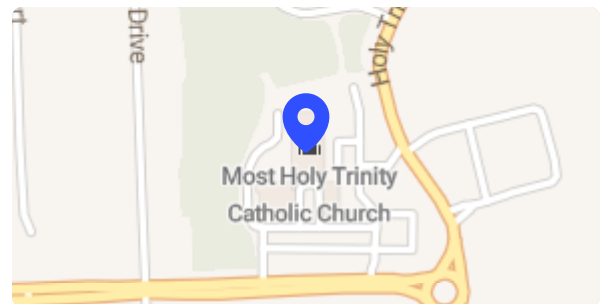

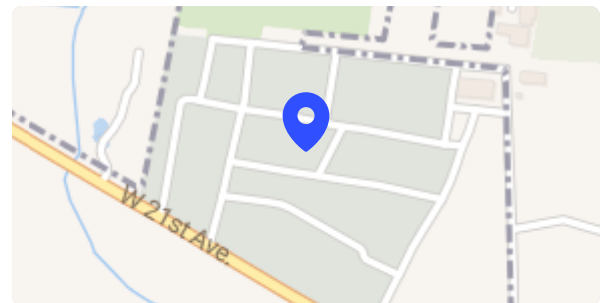

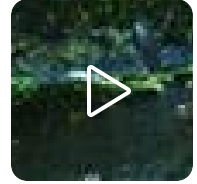
