**C**arvin "CJ" Ladner, born on November 22, 1947, passed away peacefully May 31, 2023, in Gulfport, MS. He was 75. Born in Gulfport, MS, he lived in Slidell since 1978.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Norma Foley Ladner, his parents, Carvis and Loretta Ladner, and his brothers, Jesse "Jake" Ladner and Billy J. Ladner.

He is survived by his children, Michele L. Mills (Brent), and Brian J. Ladner (Christine); his sister, Dale Ladner; his grandchildren, Hayden and Brady Mills, Katie, Josh, Andrew and Matthew Ladner; his sisters-in-law, Cathy Ladner and Beverly "Bit" Ladner, and several nieces and nephews.

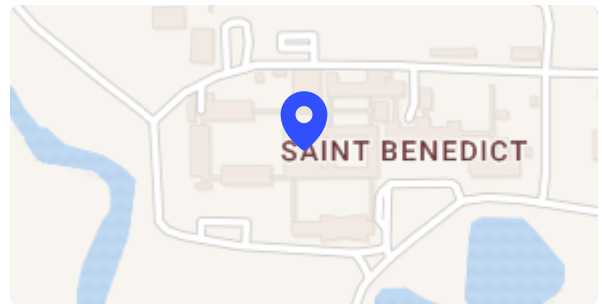

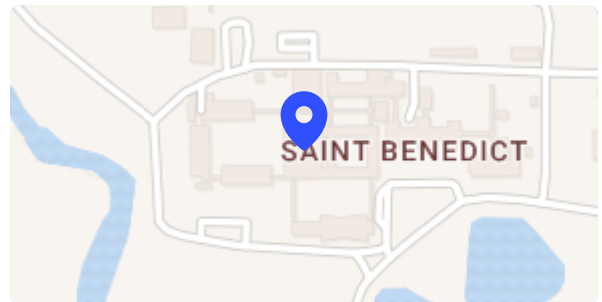

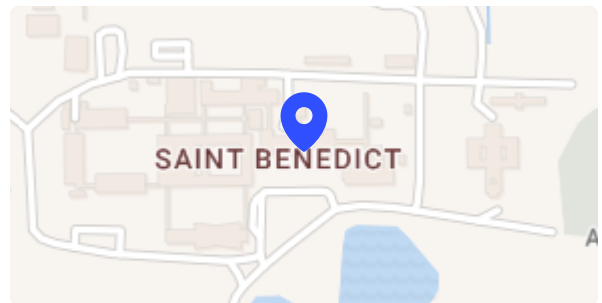
