Samuel Morris Gordon passed away on Thursday, June 15, 2023 at the age of 89. He was born on November 17, 1933 in New York, NY to the late Benjamin Goldfarb Gordon and Belle Pocker Goldfarb Gordon. At age 19, Sam joined the United States Marine Corps. He went in as a private first class, served for 21 years, including a tour in Vietnam, and retired as a Captain. After retiring from the Corps, Sam was an insurance agent for Metropolitan Life Insurance.

Sam was the beloved husband of Mary Ann Dixon Gordon. He was the loving father of Claire Gordon Cullipher, Diane Gordon; stepdaughters, Deborah Marr and Sheryl Van Duym.
