Edward M. Trapp, aged 95, passed into eternal life on January 25, 2024. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He is survived by his beloved wife Carolyn and siblings Patricia Strassburger, Marilyn Condon, Michael (Shirley), and Anne Van Leer (John). Other survivors include his children, Timothy, Dianna Starr, Shawn (Barbara), and stepchildren Donna Ibert (John), Charles Fazzio (Jessica), and Lisa Schmidt. After retiring, he was active as a geophysical consultant for several years and remained active in the petroleum industry throughout the remainder of his life as a board member of FORTESA INTL.

His work required moving from time to time and ultimately he lived in 8 states and, at one time, 6 years in London, England. Frequent travel was also required and carried over into his retirement years as he and Carolyn enjoyed road trips, tours, and cruising.
