Michael "Mickey" Arlen Bryan passed away peacefully on April 1, 2024 at the age of 83. Mickey was born in Bogalusa, Louisiana on June 8, 1940 to John Frances Bryan and Dorothy Louise Baker Bryan. Mickey is survived by his wife, Betty Brand Bryan, and his daughters, Teri Seal and husband Matthew Seal, and Traci McMillan and husband Scott McMillan. He was a loving grandfather to three grandsons Knox, Hunt and Cole McMillan. He was preceded in death by his father, John Bryan and his mother, Dorothy Baker Bryan.

A native of Bogalusa and proud resident of Covington, Louisiana for over 50 years, Mickey graduated from Bogalusa High School in 1958.

After high school he attended Louisiana State University and began his professional career as a State Trooper with the Louisiana State Police in 1965. Mickey retired as Captain and Commander of the Criminal Intelligence Division of the Louisiana State Police in 1985.

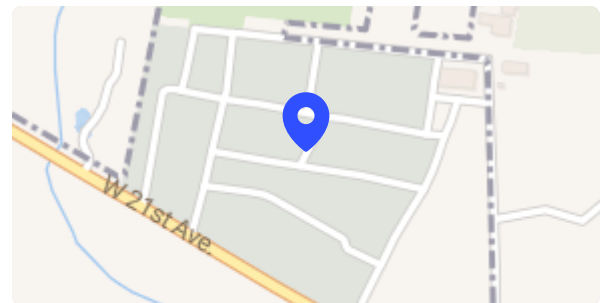

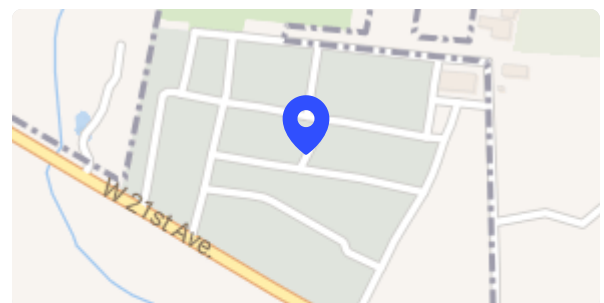
