# Warner David Broussard

**W**arner David Broussard, age 81, of Covington, passed away on Monday, May 13, 2024. He was born on March 5, 1943, in New Iberia, Louisiana.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Louis Joseph Broussard and Armide Barras Broussard.

He is survived by his daughter whom he loved more than life itself, April Broussard Barilleaux (David); brother, Donald Broussard (Sheryl); nephews, Donald Broussard, Jeffrey Broussard, and Donnie Broussard; his dog, Maggie; many granddogs; and many close friends and extended family members.

A native French-speaking Acadian, David moved from New Iberia to New Orleans at the young age of 3, where he quickly learned to take a streetcar to the doctor's office (even while completely healthy) for free candy. He graduated from John McDonogh High School before earning his welding certificate at Delgado Community College. 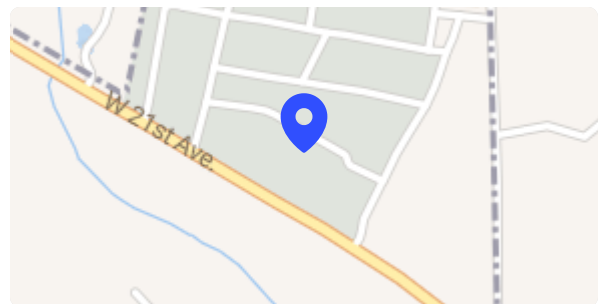

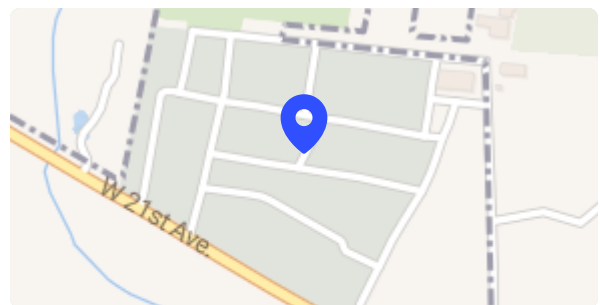

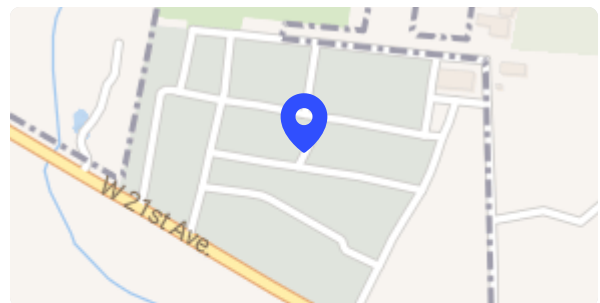
