Arthemise, or Artie, as was she was known, was born on her family's farm in Bush Louisiana on November 10, 1936. Artie was the 7th of 8 children born to Louis Revere and Elsie Sharp Revere. She attended St Peter's School, and was a graduate of Covington High School.

During her senior year in high school while visiting her sister in New Orleans, Artemise met Lev Willis, who she would go on to marry and with whom she would share the next 63 years.

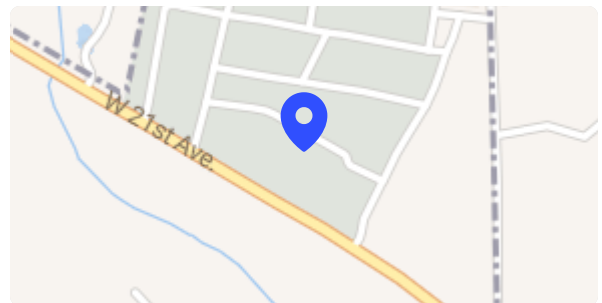

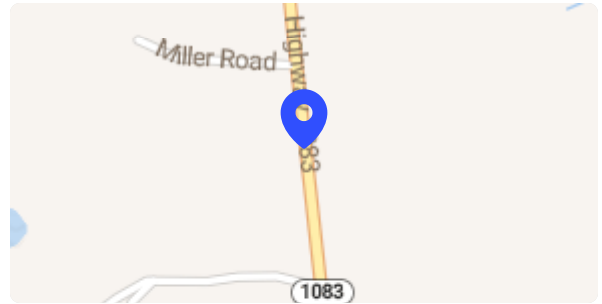
