It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Norman James "Chock" Gaspard on Saturday, May 17, 2025 at the age of 79. He was born in New Orleans, LA on June 23, 1945.

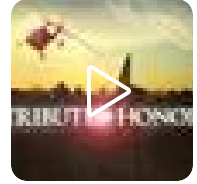
