# Jacqueline Brumfield

Jacqueline Brumfield, age 89, of Fort Lauderdale, FL, passed away on July 16, 2025. She was born on August 19, 1935 in Trenton, New Jersey.

She is survived by her loving children and their spouses, Richard H. Schulze Jr., Linda and Gene Monaco, and John and Rajean Schulze; grandchildren, Ashlee Williams, Adriane Anderson, Christopher Keefer, Stuart Keefer, Julianna Schulze, and Emma Schulze; and great-grandchildren, Gabriel Cleveland, Jacob Cleveland, Samuel Williams, Oliver Keefer, and Eloise Keefer. She is also survived by her many extended family members and friends.

She was preceded in death by her loving husband of 32 years, Byron Butler Brumfield and her parents, John and Miriam Van Luppen.

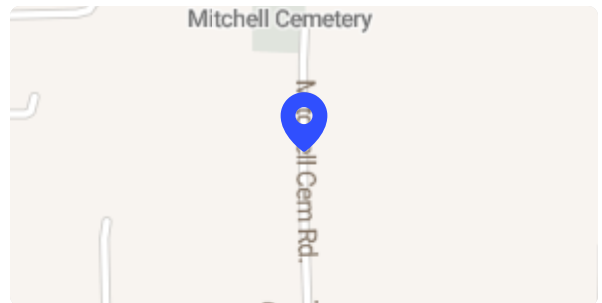

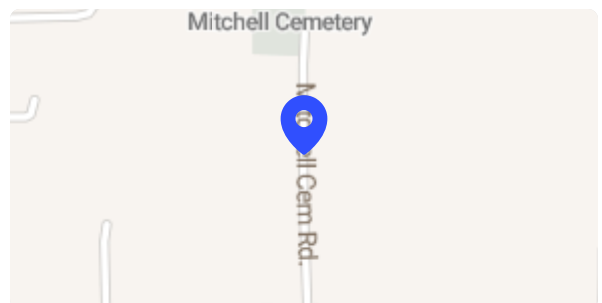
