Burnley Bentley “Bunny” Foster born January 25, 1950 in St. Andrew, Jamaica, passed away on August 28, 2025 in Madisonville, LA. He was known for his laid-back spirit, generous heart and deep love for his family.

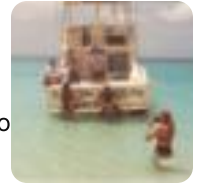

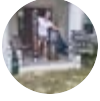
