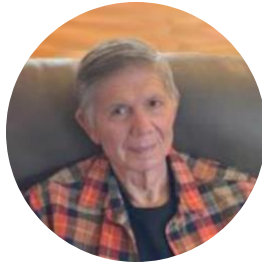

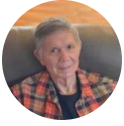
Mr. Baldwin was an avid gardener who loved being outdoors. He also had a passion for photography and was a freelance photographer. He will be greatly missed and forever remembered.

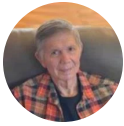

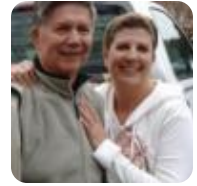

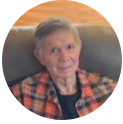
