Alvin "Al" Carter, age 75, of Covington, Louisiana, passed away on Thursday, December 25, 2025. He was born on September 6, 1950 in New Orleans, Louisiana. 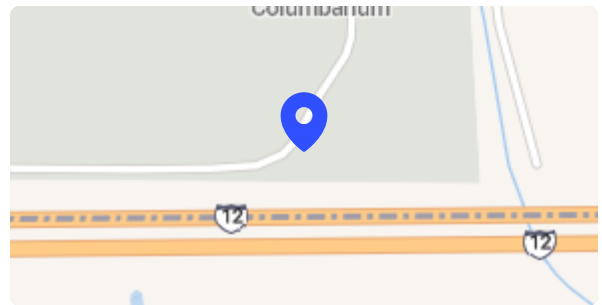

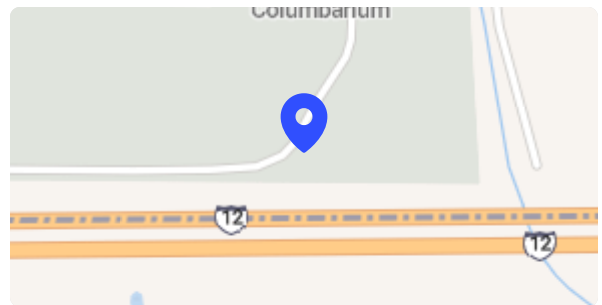

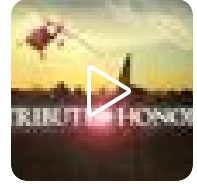
